

## STRENGTHENING THE CHURCH AT HOME

#### Dear Father,

Mission dioceses are not found only in faraway locations overseas. They also exist here at home, throughout the United States and its territories. These are dioceses that have small Catholic populations dispersed over a wide geographic territory, experience economic hardships caused by loss of industries, or have diminishing populations because of migration from rural to urban areas. For all these reasons, mission dioceses need financial help from Catholic Home Missions to support their ministries.

Parishes in your diocese will soon take up the Catholic Home Missions Appeal to help mission dioceses minister to the unique pastoral needs of the people they serve. You can support this appeal by mentioning it at Mass on collection weekend and by using the social media tool kit, bulletin insert, and web ads found at www.usccb.org/home-missions.

The Diocese of Superior, in northwestern Wisconsin, is a good example of a home mission diocese. It serves a territory that exceeds 15,700 square miles—more than twice the size of the state of Massachusetts—with rural towns and small cities. Only a small number of priests are available to celebrate Mass and attend to parishioners' other pastoral needs. But the diocese has developed a vocations-team approach to encourage young men to explore priestly vocations. With critical funding from Catholic Home Missions, the vocations team brings together priests of various ages and experience levels, along with a lay team member, to recruit, support, and determine the suitability of candidates for seminary. Using this team approach, the diocese is heightening interest in priestly life among young men through "Come and See" weekend retreats and semiannual St. Andrew Dinners, where young men and their parents can get answers to their questions and concerns about seminary and priestly life.

When you participate in the annual Catholic Home Missions Appeal—via a second collection or as part of your parish and diocesan stewardship ministry—you make possible the development of priestly vocations in Superior and more than 70 other dioceses throughout the United States and its territories.

# WHAT IS A "HOME MISSION" DIOCESE?

Home mission dioceses are those dioceses in the United States, its territories, and former territories that cannot provide basic pastoral services without outside help. Basic pastoral services include Mass, the sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters, and laypeople. Right now, nearly 40% of dioceses in United States and its territories are considered home missions.

### ¿QUÉ ES UNA DIÓCESIS "MISIONERA"?






