**Dear Pastor/Parish Administrator,**

Human trafficking and the abuse of children and vulnerable people are two serious violations of human dignity that demand urgent and comprehensive responses from the Church, governments, and human rights organizations. By working to heal the wounds of victims and their family members, bring perpetrators to justice, and implement awareness and prevention programs, the Church is bringing hope and helping to end abuse and trafficking.

In Venezuela's Archdiocese of Caracas, an anti-trafficking project—combining education, communication, training, and cooperation among ecclesiastical leaders, civil authorities, nongovernmental human rights organizations, and others—used grants from the Collection for the Church in Latin America to combat human trafficking in the region. This broad approach addressed the needs of victims and implemented programs to train civic officials, human rights advocates, and professionals in ways to combat trafficking.

In Peru, the Prelature of Chuquibambilla asked the Collection for the Church in Latin America to help it create, fund, and implement a program to prevent abuse of children and vulnerable people through a three-part training for Church leaders, alliance-building initiatives with health-care and law enforcement organizations, and the creation of protocols to address reported incidents of abuse.

Your support for the Collection for the Church in Latin America is vital to these efforts to prevent and end the violation of those most vulnerable among us.

## Simple Steps for a Successful Collection for the Church in Latin America

**1 Announce** the collection. Use the parish appeal and bulletin announcements—including stories of projects funded by the collection—to tell parishioners what the collection is and how it makes a difference. **This is the best way to ensure the success of the collection.**

**2 Preach** about the challenges facing the Church in Latin America and the Caribbean. Issues include lack of access to education in the faith and to resources that strengthen the faith. The collection helps by funding catechetical programs, youth ministry, and leadership training for priests, seminarians, religious, and lay ministers. The stories provided to you (as well as many more on the program's website) can enhance your preaching about Scripture and the collection.

**3 Pray** for the Church in Latin America as it works to provide basic pastoral care to parishioners and share the faith with future generations. Use the intercessions and the "Prayer for Solidarity" in this resource to unite your parish with these communities.

**4 Share** collection information on your social media channels and website using the web banners and social media tool kit available online. Some of the collection's posts include timely announcements, information about grantees, and information about other events in Latin America and the Caribbean. Like and follow the USCCB's Facebook page ([www.Facebook.com/USCCB](http://www.Facebook.com/USCCB)) to view images and videos and to read stories about the life-saving work of the collection. Comment and share the posts with parishioners.




### Expenses
